Rep. Paul Baumbach's bills – HB 281 and 282 – have been introduced and are awaiting a hearing in the House Administration Committee. These bills are important to retirees because they address the problems that we faced in our fight to keep our healthcare benefits. Twenty (20) representatives have signed onto the bills as “co-prime” or “co-sponsors.” We need thirty (30) to make the bills “veto-proof.”
